STATEMENT FROM THE OCEANIA PROVINCE OF THE CHRISTIAN BROTHERS – NOTIFIABLE DATA BREACH

14 August 2020

In line with our obligations, the Oceania Province of the Christian Brothers has reported to the Police and the Office of the Australian Information Commissioner (OAIC) a Notifiable Data Breach under the 1988 Privacy Act.

The issue was identified as a result of a security breach which resulted in funds being fraudulently stolen. This criminal breach did not occur on our private network but via a third party.

There is no evidence to date that any personal data has been compromised however the matter has been reported to both Victoria Police and to the OAIC. A notice has also been placed on our website in accordance with reporting obligations.

We take our responsibilities in respect of the protection of personal data very seriously and have conducted an internal investigation and further enhanced our security measures.
